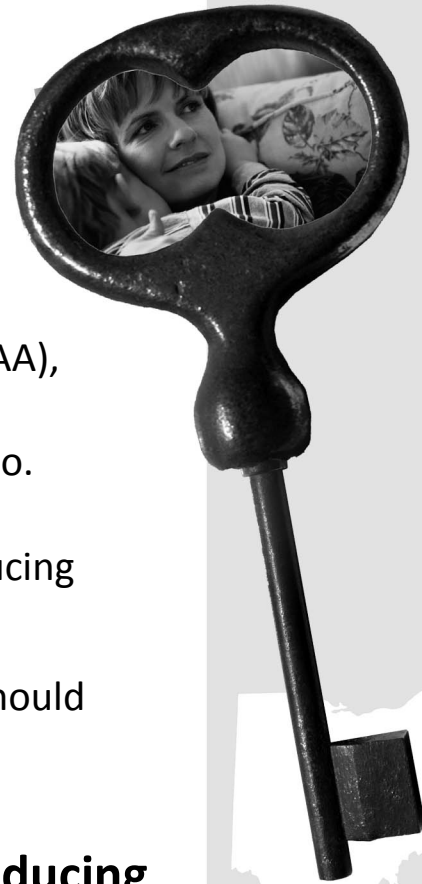


# Your voice matters. OACAA and Erie-Huron Counties Community Action Commission, Inc. want to hear from you.
